Eisele Predissertation Research Award, 2005
Department of Anthropology
Florida State University

The Florida State University Department of Anthropology invites applications for the Eisele Predissertation Research Award. This competitive award is open to second-year doctoral students in the department. It is intended to support predissertation research that will increase students' ability to secure external funding for dissertation fieldwork. Typically, awards will be made for summer research. Funding levels will be determined in part by the number and quality of applications, but we anticipate being able to offer up to three awards at a maximum amount of \$1,500 each.

The application deadline for 2005 is March 30, 2005.

A complete application will consist of the following:

1. **Project description.** The project description should be no more than five single-spaced pages plus references, formatted in 12-point font with one-inch margins. It should describe: (a) the objectives and significance of the proposed research, (b) the specific research questions or hypotheses, (c) methods and research design, (d) project timeline, (e) plans for dissemination of findings.
2. **Budget.** A maximum budget of \$1,500 is allowed. Applicants must provide an itemized budget and justification for proposed expenses. Allowable expenses include travel, equipment, materials and supplies, and compensation for research participants and assistants.
3. **Academic transcript (Unofficial),** including all graduate work.
4. **CV.**
5. **Grant Cover Sheet and Abstract.** A copy of the attached form should be filled out, signed by the student's advisor, and submitted as the first page of the application. The abstract should not exceed 150 words.
